

Why Not Try One Of These.....?

White Wine

Lost Angel Chardonnay, California, USA 2014 £27.95

Lost Angel's wines are for people who appreciate bold, edgy & iconoclastic. They are different and exciting and as the old saying goes "if you only live once, make it count and if you live more than once - who the hell cares!! Forget the heavy oak and butter! This Chardonnay shows fresh flavors of pineapple and lemon zest with bright acidity and lively freshness. Charlie is a hippy. She loves classic rock and thinks today's music is over-produced garbage. She's not a planner - she rides the waves of life. You'll find her cruisin' the open road in her VW bus.

Ella - Ancilla Lugana Lake Garda, Italy 2015 £27.95

Ancilla Lugana is located on the shores of Lake Garda in North East Italy. It is run by Luiselle Benedetti. The third generation of women to run this estate, having inherited the farm from her mother, who inherited it from her mother - named Ancilla. This is 100% turbiana grape, it is a pale straw yellow colour typical of Lugana wine. On the nose, hints of yellow fruit, grapefruit & citrus. On the palate this Lugana displays equilibrium, well balanced between sugar residues and acidity. Fermented slowly in steel vats and aged for 5 months in yeast suspension.

New Hall Signature Reserve - East Anglia, England 2014 £23.95

Established in 1969 in the village of Purleigh, this is one of the oldest wineries in England. The wine is made from Pinot Gris, Ortega & Scheurebe grapes, this wine is fresh, crisp, appley, dry, with medium body & a mineral-finish, making it a great aperitif, & would partner well with fish dishes, white meat & salads.

Turtles Single Vineyard Malagouzia, Alpha Estate, Greece 2015 25.95

Alpha Estate is located at the northwest part of Greece, the Amyndeon, Florina region. Alpha Estate was founded in 1997 viticulturist Makis Mavridis and chemist Angelos Iatridis, who, after years of experience in various locations of Greece, chose the Amyndeon region to create their own wine.

Brilliantly, light yellow in color with greenish tints. Strong and lively nose, typical Malagouzia, suggesting rose petal with floral aromas and sweet spices, melon, litchi with a note of honeysuckle. Round and mellow on the palate, fat but balanced, high in alcohol with plenty of finesse. Well structured, reminding the nose aromas with a hint of rosemary. A richly textured wine with superb length and balance. A classy wine with long finish and persistent aromas.

Sauska Dry Furmint - Tokaj Hungary 2015/16 £23.95

Christian Sauska, a Hungarian businessman who made his fortune in the US in the lighting business says he aims not only for top notch wines but also for uniqueness. His winery is located in the oldest classified wine region in Europe, Tokaj.

A captivating expression of Hungary's most famous white grape. This Furmint offers intense aromas of peach, blood orange and herbs. The palate is dry leading to a satisfying fullness in the middle and a crisp grapefruit finish.

Red Wine

Syrah, Lismore Estates Vineyard, Western Cape, S. Africa 2016 £37.95

Samantha O'keefe has produced a truly stunning Syrah from the base of the Riviersonderend Mountains. 40% of the grapes are fermented in bunches in open vats and 60% in a wooden fermenter, then transferred into wooden barrels for malolactic fermentation. Afterwards they are blended in a wooden vat and aged for 10 months. The wine produced is exotic with cassis, blackberry and cherry on the nose with hints of white pepper and flowers. And smoked bacon. This is a light and elegant Syrah, truly unique !!!

Sauska Kekfrankos - Villany Hungary 2012 £29.95

Trophy winner Best Regional Wine - Decanter Magazine 2012

Bright immediate aroma of ripe berry fruit, white pepper & rosehip leads to a medium-bodied vibrant palate. The oak influence is super subtle, complementing the natural spice & smoke notes of the Kekfrankos grape.

Manolesakis Estate, Estate Exis Red, Adriani, Greece 2016 £25.95

A combination of 55% Xinomavro and 45% Limnio grapes. Stavros Manolesakis has produced a medium bodied wine with notes of raspberry, cherry, pepper and rose petal. After setting up his own vineyards in 1989 along with his father, George, Stavos is combining both Greek grape varieties and more cosmopolitan varieties to produce truly great wines.

Chateau Ksara, Reserve du Couvent, Bekaa Valley Lebanon £26.95

Commended in the Sommelier Wine Awards 2014/15

Chateau Ksara is Lebanon's oldest winery. It can be traced back to 1857 when Jesuit monks acquired the property. Ksara is now the most modern winery in the region as well as the largest producer in the country. A complex aroma of cloves, vanilla & mulberry. On the palate it has blackberry fruits and supple tannins.

Casa Valduga Raizes Cab. Sauvignon - Campanha, Brazil 2013 £27.95

The Valduga family emigrated from Italy to Brazil in 1875 and since then has been producing wine: first for their own consumption, then in bulk. The family remains involved in every aspect of the production, even winery design. As Brazil starts to make waves on the export market, Casa Valduga is one of the pioneering wineries setting the pace.

Fine Wines

White Wine

Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 2013 Les Champs Gains

Michel Bouzereau et fils, Burgundy, France £112.95

Michel produces a nervy and savoury style of wines that take a little longer to come out of their shell, but have an intense, racy quality that is well worth the wait.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc 'Magis' 2012 Rotem &

Mounir Saouma £122.95

The style of this wine is fascinating & unique -very much Chateauneuf viewed through a prism of Burgundy. The flavours are Grenache, but structurally, in their combination of delicacy & power, there is more than a little of the Cote d'Or Grand Cru about this wine

Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru 2012 LucienLe Moine,

Burgundy, France £184.95

It is hard to find a more perfectionist address in the whole of Burgundy, this extraordinary wine literally has to be tasted to be believed- incredibly balanced and poised, it is a breed apart

Red Wine

Chateau Kirwan 2008 Margaux Bordeaux £107.50

One of the best loved third growths in Medoc. It is situated in the commune of Cantenac, overlooking the Garonne estuary owned by the Schyler family since 1925. A medium bodied Margaux with good depth of cassis, blackberry & smoke and a freshness on the palate.

Brunello di Montalcino Riserva 2007 Poggia Antico

Tuscany £124.95

A beautifully layered, expressive wine which caresses the palate with exceptional elegance, finesse & total class. Sage, rosemary, licorice & tobacco. This is without question one of the very best 2007 Riservas - *The Wine Advocate* June 2013

Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru 2010 La Richemone

Perrot-Minot Burgundy France £179.95

One of "The" Burgundy names. Its secret is old vines and minimal intervention- no racking, fining or filtration, resulting in a quite stunning wine

Chateau Musar - Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

2006 - £53

1997 - Big, well-balanced with a very slow fermentation.

Exotic, smoky nose. Redcurrant, cinnamon and spice flavours with a fresh acidity. Definitely a Bordeaux-style vintage!!

1998 - A relatively pale, light vintage. Mature, classic with sweet cedary and spice aromas. Soft tannins and great length with graceful flavours of wheat and raisins.

1999 - Brilliant deep red with a nose full of red and black fruits. If 1997 was a Bordeaux style this vintage dons its hat to the Rhône with nuances of vanilla and chocolate.

2006 - Beautiful deep ruby hue with lots of almost confected cherry, blackcurrant & cranberries on the nose with a hint of liquorice. Palate is hedgerow fruits, blueberries & cherries. A mid-weight vintage with excellent acidity & fine tannins. Released only in 2017, 4 years later than usual.
